	5 – 4 WRF (Four to a Wild Royal Flush)
	6 – 4 OSF (Four to an Outside Straight Flush)
	7 – 2 Deuces
One-Deuce Hands	1 – WRF (Wild Royal Flush)
	2 – 5K (Five of a Kind)
	3 – SF (Straight Flush)
	4 – 4K (Four of a Kind)
	5 – 4 WRF (Four to a Wild Royal Flush)
	6 – FH (Full House)
	7 – FL (Flush)
	8 – 4 OSF (4 to an Outside Straight Flush: 2 plus 3-4-5 or higher); or 4 ISF (Inside Straight Flush), 4 low or higher
	9 – ST (Straight)
	10 – 4 ISF (e.g., 2-3-4-6, 2-3-5-6, or 4 ISF low or higher, 2 gaps among non-wilds)
	11 – 3K (Three of a Kind)
	12 – 4 ISF, Ace low among non-wilds
	13 – 3 WRF, no Ace
	14 – 3 OSF (Outside Straight Flush), 2 plus 6 low or higher
	15 – 3 WRF, includes Ace
No-Deuce Hands	16 – 3 OSF (e.g., 2-4-5, 2-4-6), or 3 ISF (Inside Straight Flush), 5 low or higher among non-wilds
	17 – Hold only the 2
	1 – RF (Royal Flush)
	2 – 4 RF (Four to a Royal Flush)
	3 – SF (Straight Flush)
	4 – 4K (Four of a Kind)
	5 – FH (Full House)
	6 – FL (Flush)
	7 – ST (Straight)
	8 – 3K (Three of a Kind)
	9 – 4 SF (Four to a Straight Flush)
	10 – 3 RF (Three to a Royal Flush)
	11 – 4 FL (Four to a Flush)
	12 – 2 Pair
	13 – 3 OSF, 5 or higher (Three to an Outside Straight Flush)
	14 – 1 Pair
	15 – 4 OST, 4 or higher (Four to an Outside Straight)
	16 – 3 ISF examples:
	• 3-4-6, 3-5-6
	• 3 ISF, 3 low or higher, 2 gaps
	• 3 ISF: 3-4-5, 4-5-6, or 4 low or higher, 1 gap
	17 – Suited J-10, Q-10, or Q-J
	18 – 3 SF, A-3-4, A-3-5, or A-4-5 (Three to a Straight Flush)
	19 – 4 IST, includes A-K-Q-J (Four to an Inside Straight)
	20 – Suited K-10, K-J, or K-Q
	21 – Discard all
